



CPR & Emergency First Aid (Green Book)

Module purpose	This module provides the learner with the knowledge, skills and competencies to provide basic first aid and emergency life support for persons suffering injury or illness at work.
For whom	All personnel who are required to work in the vicinity of live electrical apparatus.
Prerequisites	Initial first aid course containing: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation• Shock Management• Burns Management• Methods of release of victim from contact with live conductors• Bleeding Control
Summary of content	This module meets the minimum requirements identified in the Code of Practice on Electrical Safety for the Distribution Businesses (Green Book) and contains: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Safety assessment at the scene• Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (C.P.R)• Managing the unconscious patient• Controlling external bleeding• Shock• Burns – electrical / chemical• Recording and reporting• Summoning medical assistance• Personal hygiene techniques
