Module purpose	This module provides the learner with the knowledge and skills to perform a rescue from a tower or lattice structure.
For whom	All personnel required to climb towers and lattice type structures.
Prerequisites	Satisfactory completion of Tower Climbing course.
Summary of content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prevention of Falls Regulations• Climbing equipment<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Harness, restraint lanyards, straps• Karabina's, PPE• Preparation of rescue kits• Pre-climbing – Assessment, hazards, notify emergency services and make safe via VNSC (Victorian Network System Control)• Safe climbing of towers• Assess injury• Correct positioning of attachment sling, transfer and lowering• Single person and two person rescue
