<b>Assessment</b>	Practical Assessment using traffic management scenarios and use of the Stop / slow bat in controlled situation with moving vehicle
<b>Planned duration</b>	Training session: Initial: 4 hours Refresher: 2 hours Assessment: 20 minutes
<b>Frequency</b>	Two yearly Assessment / Refresher Training, or as industry and Traffic Management Act requirements change.
